## SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. SCHEDULE

1.1. Lasers and Laser Radials will start together.

1.2. Eight (8) races are scheduled as follows:

Tuesday	July 9 AM	3 races max	1000		(session 1)
Tuesday	July 9 PM	3 races max	See SSI 1.3		(session 2)
Wednesday	July 10 AM	3 races max	1000	1200	(session 3)

1.3. To alert boats that a succeeding race in a session will begin soon, the race committee will make multiple sounds one minute before the warning signal is made.

1.4. Flag A displayed, with no sound, while boats are finishing means “No more racing this session”.

### 2. CLASS FLAGS

Class	Flag
C/C 420	420 or pennant 2
Lasers	Laser or pennant 1

### 3. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE AND LOCATION

3.1. Signals made ashore will be displayed at the SSYC flag mast.

3.2. When flag AP is displayed ashore, “1 minute” is replaced with “not less than 30 minutes” and add “Boats shall not leave the docks prior to removal.” in the race signal AP.

3.3. The Official Notice Board will be on the wall of the dock house on the NE corner of the SSYC grounds and the area of the “Race Desk” in the SSYC clubhouse..

### 4. MARKS

4.1. The rounding marks shown in the course diagrams will be orange or yellow inflated buoys or hard cylinder or spherical buoys.

4.2. New marks will be an inflated buoy a color different than the original mark.

### 5. STARTING LINE

The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee vessel and the course side of the starting mark OR a staff displaying an orange flag on another race committee vessel.

### 6. TIME LIMITS

6.4 The following time limits will apply:

Class	Mark 1 Time Limit	Race Time Limit	Finishing Window
All	20 minutes	60 minutes	15 minutes*

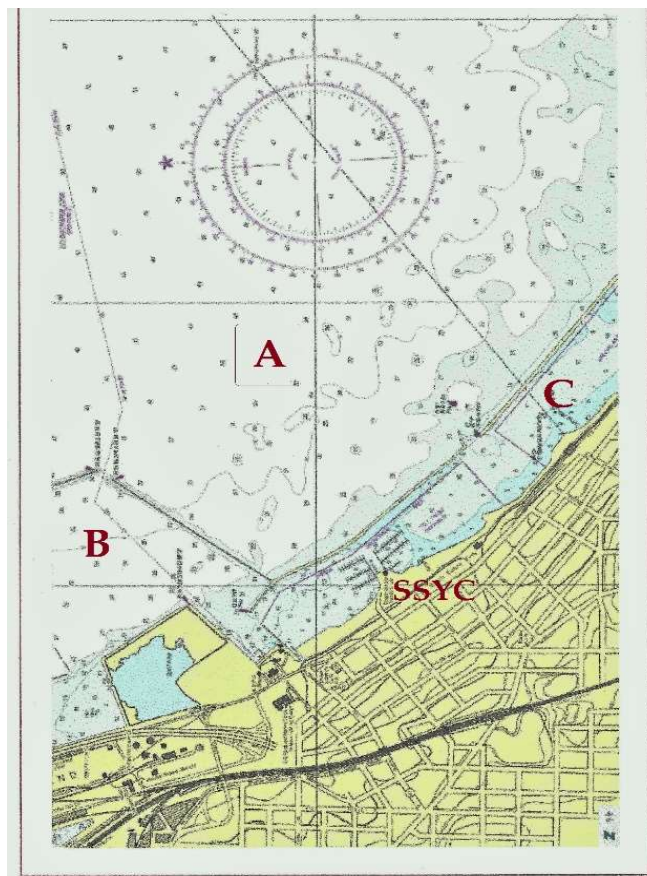
- 6.4 If no boat has passed Mark 1 within the Mark 1 Time Limit the race will be abandoned. This changes RRS 35 and 62.1(a).
- 6.3 Boats failing to finish within the Finishing Window will be scored DPI, Discretionary Penalty Imposed, without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5. The score for this DPI will be two points more than the score of the last boats that did finish within the Finishing Window.
- 6.4 The Protest Time Limit, SI 13.2, is changed to 75 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day, or 60 minutes after the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later.

## 7. SUPPORT BOATS

- 7.1. Team leaders, coaches and other support persons shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the warning signal for the first class to start until all boats have finished or retired or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.
- 7.2. Support boats shall be marked with a yellow flag provided by the SSYC Kaszube Cup Committee. And, they must have and operate a working VHF radio on channel 69.
- 7.3. Coaching shall be allowed only outside the course area beyond the start and finish lines and the lay lines on either side. The start and finish line areas extend beyond the line for a distance equal to the length of the line.
