SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 1.1** The Official Race Office is located on the main floor of the SSYC Clubhouse. Signals made ashore will be displayed at the SSYC flag mast.
- 1.2** The Official Notice Board will be the wall of the dock house on the NE corner of the SSYC grounds.

2 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 2.1** When flag AP is displayed ashore, “1 minute“ is replaced with not less than **30 minutes“** and add “Boats shall not leave the docks prior to removal.“ in the race signal AP.

3 SCHEDULE

- 3.1** Lasers and Laser Radials will start together.
- 3.2** Eight (**8**) races are scheduled as follows:

Tuesday	July 9 AM	3 races max	Session 1
Tuesday	July 9 PM	3 races max	Session 2
Wednesday	July 10 AM	3 races max	Session 3

- 3.3** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is **1000 hrs.**
- 3.4** To alert boats that a succeeding race in a session will begin soon, the race committee will make multiple sounds approximately **1 minute** before the warning signal is made.
- 3.5** Flag A displayed, with no sound, while boats are finishing means “No more racing this session“.
- 3.6** On Wednesday no warning signal will be made after **1000 hrs.**

4 CLASS FLAGS

<u>Class</u>	<u>Flag</u>
C420	420 or pennant 2
Laser/Laser Radial	Laser or pennant 1

5 THE COURSES

5.1 The race areas and course diagrams are shown in Appendix A, below.

6 MARKS

6.1 The rounding marks shown in the course diagrams will be orange or yellow inflated buoys or hard or spherical buoy.

6.2 New marks will be an inflated buoy of a color different than the original mark.

7 THE START

7.1 Races will be started using Appendix U, audible-signal racing system.

7.2 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee vessel at the starboard end and the course side of the starting mark OR a staff displaying an orange flag on race committee vessel.

8 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

To change the next leg of the course, the race committee may move the mark.

9 TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

10 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

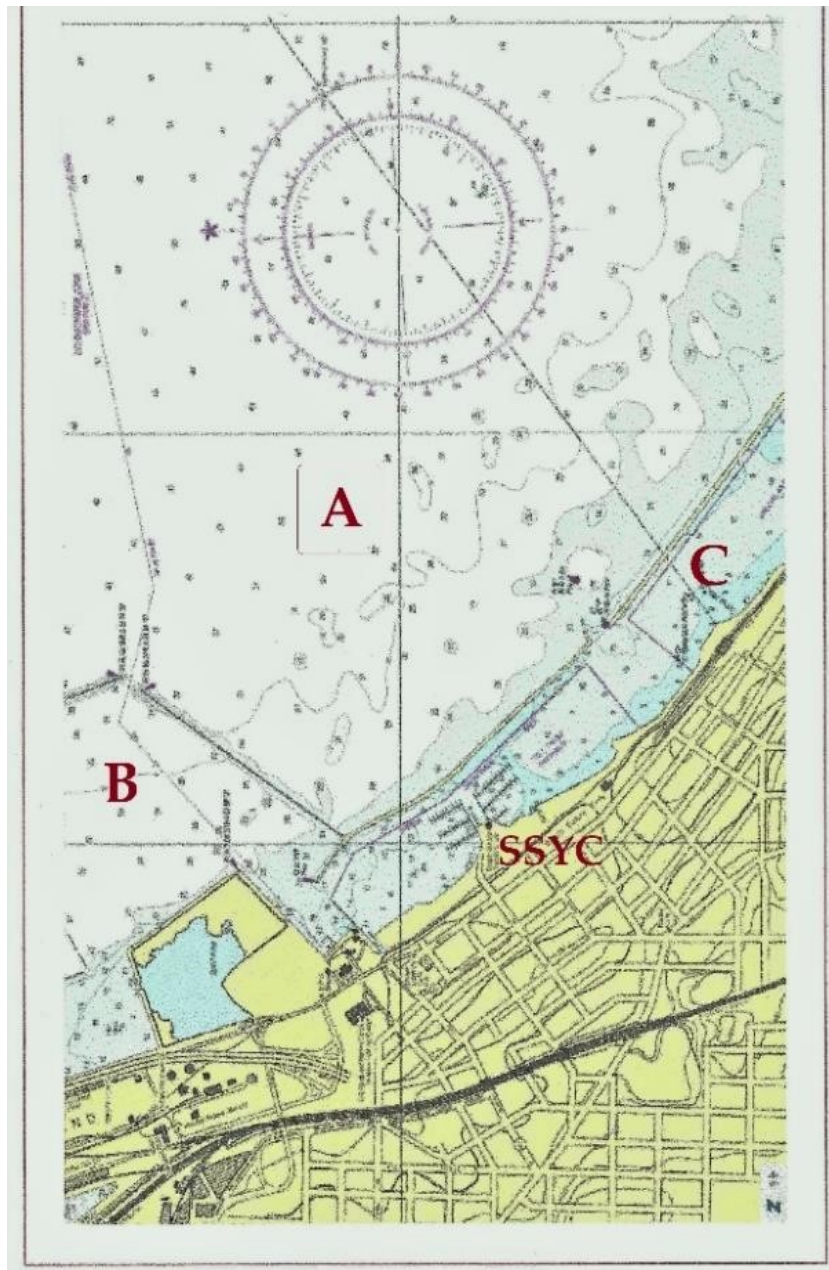
- 10.1** Notify the Race Committee signal vessel on the water of any protest to be filed.
Sail by the stern of the signal vessel after the race or before heading in to shore.

11 [DP] SUPPORT TEAMS

- 11.1** Team leaders, coaches and other support persons shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first start until all boats have finished or retired or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.
- 11.2** Support boats shall be marked with the yellow flag provided by the SSSYC Kaszube Cup Committee, and must have and operate a working VHF radio on channel, ⁱ .
- 11.3** Coaching shall be allowed only outside the course area beyond the start and finish lines and the lay lines on either side. The start and finish line areas extend beyond the line for a distance equal to the length of the line.
