SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RACE DESK AND SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 1.1 The Official Race Office is located on the main floor of the SSYC Clubhouse. Signals made ashore will be displayed at the SSYC flag mast.
- 1.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, “1 minute” is replaced with “not less than 30 minutes” and add “Boats shall not leave the docks prior to removal.” in the race signal AP.
- 1.3 The Official Notice Board will be wall of the dock house on the NE corner of the SSYC grounds.

2 SCHEDULE

- 2.1 Lasers and Laser Radials will start together.
- 2.2 Eight (8) races are scheduled for as follows:

Tuesday, July 13	AM	3 races max	(session one)
Tuesday, July 13	PM	3 races max	(session two)
Wednesday, July 14	AM	3 races max	(session three)

- 2.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1000.
- 2.4 To alert boats that a succeeding race in a session will begin soon, the race committee will make multiple sounds one minute before the warning signal is made.
- 2.4 Flag A displayed, with no sound, while boats are finishing means “No more racing this session”.
- 2.5 On Wednesday no warning signal will be made after 1200.

3 CLASS FLAGS

Laser/Laser Radial	Laser or pennant 1

4 THE COURSES

The race areas and course diagrams are on the pages following SI 9

5 MARKS

- 5.1 The rounding marks shown in the course diagrams will be a yellow MarkSetBot buoy on a floating platform, or an orange or yellow inflated buoys or hard cylinder or spherical buoy.

5.2 New marks will be an inflated buoy a color different than the original mark.

6 THE START

The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee vessel at the starboard end and the course side of the starting mark OR a staff displaying an orange flag on race committee vessel.

7 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

To change the next leg of the course, the race committee may move the mark.

8 TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

8.1

Class	Time limit	Mark 1 time limit	Finishing Window
All	60 minutes	20 minutes	15 minutes*

8.2 The score for TLE will be two points more than the score of the last boats that did finish within the Finishing Window.

9 [DP] SUPPORT TEAMS

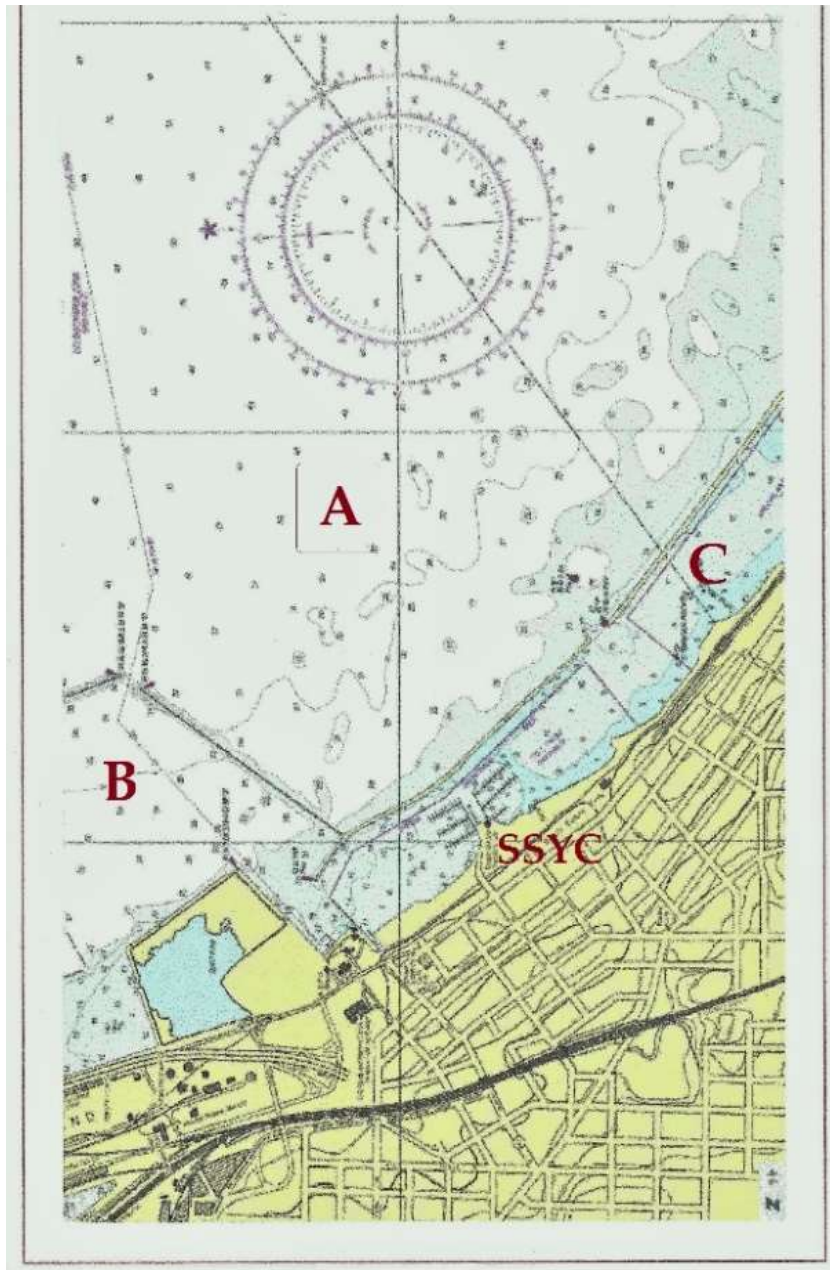
9.1 Team leaders, coaches and other support persons shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first start until all boats have finished or retired or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

9.2 Support boats shall be marked with the yellow flag provided by the SSYC Kaszube Cup Committee, and must have and operate a working VHF radio on channel 69.

9.3 Coaching shall be allowed only outside the course area beyond the start and finish lines and the lay lines on either side. The start and finish line areas extend beyond the line for a distance equal to the length of the line.
