NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1 RULES**

1.1 The Kaszube Cup Regatta (Regatta) will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 Racing rule 61 will be changed as follows: Protest Requirements will be changed so that a protesting boat shall also notify the race committee of her intent and the protested boat number. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

1.3 If there is a conflict between this notice and the sailing instructions, the protest committee will hear and apply the RC's intention of the SI(s) concerned. This amends rule 63.7.

### **2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

2.1 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the Instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and the supplementary Sailing Instructions posted by midnight on Sunday, July 17, 2022 on the Official Notice Board located on SSYC derrick house, and/or online as listed under 13 - Further Information

### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

3.1 This regatta is open to all boats of the Club/Collegiate 420, ILCA 7 (Standard), ILCA 6 (Radial), and Optimist classes that meet the following requirements:

- Club/Collegiate 420, ILCA 6 and ILCA 7 competitors' and alternates' shall be age 13 through 19 years during the calendar year, and shall not turn 20 until after the last day of the regatta, and/or
- Optimist competitors shall be age 8 through 15 years old during the calendar year, and shall not turn 16 until after the last day of the regatta.
  - Green Fleet: Class requirements,
  - White Fleet: competitors age 8 through 10 years,
  - Blue Fleet: competitors age 11 through 12 years,
  - Red Fleet: competitors age 13 through 15 years.
- A minimum of 5 boats must register by Sunday, July 17th to form a class.

3.2 To be considered an entry and be scored in the regatta, a boat shall complete all registration steps including a signed waiver (see NoR 3.3) and pay all fees.

3.3 A parent or legal guardian of every competitor (skippers and crew) shall sign the SSYC Juniors Foundation Liability and Waiver Agreement before they participate in any race of the regatta. This form is available to review in advance [www.ssyccjuniors.org](http://www.ssyccjuniors.org) website and can be e-signed when registering. Paper forms will be available onsite if needed. The link for online entry are listed under 13 - Further Information. Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: A completed entry form, signed waiver form and fees paid (including late fee) shall be submitted at registration.

3.4 The total number of competitors will be limited to 125 in order of registration received (registration includes online entry forms, release waiver and fees paid).

3.5 Competitors shall provide their own boat

## **4 FEES**

4.1 The entry fee is \$95.00 per competitor, to be paid upon registering online at [www.ssy juniors.org](http://www.ssy juniors.org). The entry fee, at a minimum, includes a Lake Michigan Sail Racing Federation youth membership (1-year, \$20 value), breakfast on Tuesday and Wednesday, swag bag and awards presentation.

4.2 Breakfast is included in registration. Complete meal wristband is available for \$35. Individual meals will be served on Tuesday and Wednesday at a cost of \$15 per meal. Complete meal wristbands will be available for purchase through the registration link at [www.ssy juniors.org](http://www.ssy juniors.org). Individual meals are able to be purchased on site with cash.

4.3 **All entries submitted after 1159 CDT on Thursday, July 14, 2021 will require a late entry fee of an additional \$25.00 per competitor** (total of \$140 per competitor for late registration). No registrations will be allowed after 0800 on Tuesday, July 19, 2022.

## **5 SCHEDULE**

5.1 Competitor check in will be Tuesday, July 19, 2022, 0700-0830 CDT

5.2 Late Registration is available, only with prior written approval from the registration committee.

5.3 Welcome to Competitors Meeting will be Tuesday, July 19, 2022 0830 CDT

5.4 A maximum of 8 races are scheduled on the following dates:

Tuesday, July 19 - 6 races maximum, with a lunch break

Wednesday, July 20 - remaining races, AM only

5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1000 CDT.

## **6 VENUE**

The racing areas will be on the waters of Lake Michigan East of SSYC and in the Milwaukee Harbor North or South of SSYC.

## **7 COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Windward-Leeward of 2, 3, 4, or 5 legs.

## **8 SCORING**

8.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

8.2 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores.

## **9 SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats shall display a flag provided by the Kaszube race committee.

## **10 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded to each competitor of the first, second and third place boats in the ILYA 6, ILYA 7 and C420 classes.

Optimist class prizes will also be awarded in each of the Red, Blue, White, and Green fleets according to the following schedule:

1-3 boats in fleet - 1 prize

4-5 boats in fleet - 2 prizes

6 or more boats in fleet - 3 prizes

## **11 RISK STATEMENT**

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

## **12 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
