

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will consist of the Instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and the supplementary Sailing Instructions posted by midnight July 7, 2019 on the Official Notice Board located on SSYC derrick house, or online as listed under **13, Further Information**

6 VENUE

The racing areas will be on the waters of Lake Michigan East of SSYC and in the Milwaukee Harbor North or South of SSYC.

7 COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:
Windward-Leeward of 2, 3, 4, or 5 legs.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 8.2 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores.

9 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall display a flag provided by the Kaszube Cup committee.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

- a) To each member of the crews placing first through fifth in each class in the regatta.
- b) Optimist class prizes will also be awarded in each of the Red, Blue, White, and Green fleets according to the following schedule:
 - 1-3 boats in fleet - 1 prize
 - 4-5 boats in fleet - 2 prizes
 - 6 or more boats in fleet - 3 prizes

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
